



The e-ASIA Joint Research Program Workshop on Cancer Research

On the 24th – 25th of August 2018, an international medical workshop on cancer research will take place in the Far Eastern Federal University (Russia, Vladivostok). This workshop will be held as side event of the e-Asia JRP 7th Annual Board Meeting with participation of leading researchers in the field of cancer research from Asia-Pacific region.

The goal of the event is to foster the development of international scientific cooperation and to attract public attention to emerging cancer problems, to foster exchange of authoritative opinions of leading scientists and the exchange of therapeutic cancer treatment international experience. The meeting will provide opportunities to form international research teams and projects for conducting joint research activities aimed at tackling oncology problems.

The event is aimed at addressing and discussing the following fundamental problems: diagnosis and treatment of all categories and conditions of diseases and disorders associated with the central and peripheral nervous system; studying and treatment of disorders and pathologies of the central nervous system, and its units, autonomic nervous system and somatic nervous system; achievements and improvement of radiation, immuno-, radio-, chemo- and targeted therapies of cancer.
